- The contest runs from November 2, 2025 to November 8, 2025;
- Winners will be selected and announced no later than November 18, 2025;
- You may enter as many times as you would like;
- All entries must be original work, taken in the state of Oklahoma, and include the location where the photograph was taken;
- Only digital photographs will be accepted:
- Digital images (.png, .jpg, .jpeg, or .gif format) must be at least 200 dpi (resolution) and not exceed 10 MB in size;
- Entries may be submitted through our 2025 Oklahoma Mobility Week Photo Contest Entry Form or email (ohook@odot.org);
- Photographer retains all copyright privileges for submitted photographs. Photographer grants unlimited, nonexclusive use license to the Mobility Management program for mobility week in 2025 and future mobility week campaigns. The Mobility Management program reserves the right to use the photos in printed materials and by electronic means to promote mobility and transportation in Oklahoma and Mobility Management programs. As conditions of this permission, the Mobility Management program shall credit photographs with proper attribution;
- The Mobility Management program is not responsible for late, lost, damaged, destroyed, or misdirected entries or for miscommunications, misdirected transmissions, or other errors of any kind, whether human or electronic;
- By entering, participants release and hold harmless the Mobility Management program and the federally funded public transit providers, as well as any employees;
- Contest entrants agree to abide by the terms of these official rules and by the decisions of the judges, which are final on all matters about the contest;
- Mobility Management program employees and their families may enter the contest but are not eligible to win; and
