














## What is Mobility Week?

#### Facts:

- Nearly 3.6 million Americans do not obtain medical care each year because of lack of transportation.
- Nearly 2 million people with disabilities never leave their home; 560,000 are related to transportation challenges.
- 3.5.4% of Oklahoma residents are zero-car households.
- One in five Americans who live in rural areas are increasingly cut off from economic and social opportunities.



#### Ways To Be Involved:



## Highlights – Norman




The City of Norman took the opportunity at the October 22, 2024, City Council Meeting to approve proclamations honoring those who make Norman a special place to live and work.




