# Pre-K Aide

## **Position Summary**

We are seeking an experienced and responsible Pre-K Aide to join our team. The Pre-K Aide is a support for the Pre-K teachers by offering instructional and logistical support.

## **Position Responsibilities**

The part-time Pre-K Aide reports to the teachers in their classrooms by 7:30 A.M. on every scheduled school day. On a daily basis the Aide:

- Escorts the Pre-K students from before care at 7:40 to the classrooms across the Parking Lot and proceeds to greet the other arriving students and assist with putting up their belongings.
- The school office personnel contacts the Aide with students checking in late and walks them into the building.
- Observes/participates in morning groups, e.g. calendar and job assignments and assists each teacher with classwork as needed and/or requested.
- Walks students to and from Creative Arts classes.
- Makes copies/cuts/staples/laminates as requested.
- Texts/calls maintenance if repairs and/or immediate janitorial services as needed.
- Replaces paper towels in classroom and kitchen.
- Restocks cleaning supplies and office supplies for each classroom from the main building.
- Places office supply and snack orders with Mrs. Haimelin as needed or per teacher request.
- Assists students with personal hygiene issues.
- Assists students with lunch in the cafeteria. Sweeps the floor and cleans tables after students have finished.
- Assists teachers with laundering nap blankets and wipes nap pads with antibacterial wipes, cleans students
  cubbies and shelves in the middle room during school breaks or Administrative Work Days.
- Other assignments as requested by teachers.
