The Southern Cameroons People's Conference (SCPC) Leadership Committee, Organizing Committee, and members of all nine thematic committees wish to thank all SCPC participants from groups, communities, and individuals for their participation and contribution towards the conference. We send special appreciation to our IDPs, refugees and APOC representatives who despite challenges were dedicated and contributed to the success of the conference. We are now moving from organization to implementation of the SCPC Resolutions.

Following a joint meeting of the SCPC Leadership and Organizing Committees on Sunday October 22, 2023, an agreement was reached to transform the SCPC Organizing Committee to the SCPC Resolution Implementation Committee. The Committee shall constitute all groups and community representatives that took part in the SCPC Organizing Committee and charged with the following:

1. To work in close collaboration with the SCPC Leadership Committee.
2. Consult with the broader Southern Cameroons (Ambazonia) Community, including refugees, IDPs, women groups, and APCs in the implementation process.
3. Continue to work with relevant Thematic Committees in the implementation of the SCPC Resolutions.
4. Put together the structures of the SCPC Secretariat as elaborated in the SCPC Resolutions and shall cease to function once the SCPC Secretariat kicks off.
5. Shall admit any group(s) or community that endorses and agrees to adhere to the SCPC Resolutions.
6. Shall invite and work with other Southern Cameroonians (Ambazonians) with relevant expertise to advice on specific issues and others in the implementation of the SCPC Resolutions.

The SCPC Resolution Implementation Committee shall develop its internal working mechanisms to ensure an effective and efficient management of its activities and report on progress being made in the implementation of the SCPC Resolution. The SCPC leadership and organizing committees unanimously agreed to extend CDN's mandate in its facilitating role to the Resolution Implementation Committee.
