



Student Medication Information for Overnight Field Trips

You may send Prescription and Non-prescription medication with your child. All medication must be turned into the designated school personnel by a parent/guardian. Medications must not be kept with students, exceptions are emergency medications with a physician's order.

Prescription medications must come in pharmacy labeled containers which display the child's name, prescription number, administration route and directions, licensed prescriber's name, pharmacy name, address and phone number.

Non-prescription medications must be in the manufacturer's packaging with the child's name clearly labeled on the container. Medication will be administered according to the manufacturer's instructions. A greater dose of non-prescription medication cannot be given without a physician's written order.

School personnel cannot give expired medication.
