Campus Wear Policy

Consistent with our mission as a classical Christian school, Providence Academy desires to enhance the learning environment. We endeavor to set a standard that glorifies God in academics, Christian character, and appearance. Campus Wear guidelines provide standards and expectations for our learning community. Adherence to the following guidelines is recognized as an act of obedience to school policies and the Lord.

Shirts

Students are permitted to wear:

1. Short or long sleeve polos. Providence Academy defines a polo as a collared shirt with two or three buttons.
2. Five options - solid navy (dark blue), burgundy, light blue, light pink, or white.
3. PA logos (no other logos except those sold in the PA Spirit Wear store).
4. Modest fits, free of tight or revealing qualities, and no sleeveless shirts.
5. Oxford button-down shirts in light blue or white. Providence Academy defines an Oxford shirt as a button-down shirt, typically featuring a button-down collar made from Oxford cloth (a durable weave with a slight texture, originally produced by Scottish fabric mills).

*Monday - Thursday, collared shirts should be worn under all PA outerwear.

Pants, Shorts, Skirts, or Jumpers

Students are permitted to wear:

1. Three options - khaki, navy (dark blue), or the official school plaid (links above).
2. Shorts, skirts, or jumpers not shorter than 5 inches from the top of the knee, while standing. The five-inch side of a 3x5 index card provides a consistent measurement.
3. Business casual or dress pant material (no joggers or elastic at the ankles).

*Sweatpants and leggings are never permitted.

Jewelry, Belts, and Accessories

Students are permitted to wear:

1. Jewelry, belts, and hair accessories that are simple and not distracting - left to the discretion of the Deans (no animal ears, horns, spikes, etc.).
2. No hats, scarves, bandanas, sock caps, visors, or sunglasses are allowed during school hours.
3. Earrings (earrings are for girls only, and only piercings of the ear).

*Tattoos, even temporary, are never permitted.

Hair Styles

Hair for all students must be clean, neat, and well-groomed. Only natural colors are permitted.

The Spirit Wear Store

Visit the Spirit Wear Store to purchase outerwear and Spirit Wear items. Items are also available via the approved vendor links above.

Shoes, Socks, and Tights

Students are permitted to wear:

1. Closed-toe shoes with no wheels. (no slides, crocs, etc., during school hours)
2. Tights, knee socks, and leggings under skirts in solid navy, burgundy, or white.

Outerwear

Outerwear is defined as anything worn over campus wear.

Students are permitted to wear:

1. Providence Academy vests, jackets, pullovers, hoodies, sweaters, and fleeces (available in the Spirit Wear Store or online from approved vendors).
2. Providence Academy logos (no other logos, unless purchased in the Spirit Wear Store or Athletic-issued and Fine Arts-issued outerwear are permitted).

*Winterwear, defined as coats, gloves, and hats, may be worn to/from school and must be left in the locker during school hours.

Winterwear and outerwear are two distinct categories. Winterwear is not expected to have a Providence Academy logo. All outerwear is expected to have the Providence Academy logo.

Spirit Wear Days

These days are reserved for Fridays, delayed-start days, and the last day of the school week. Spirit Wear may be purchased in the Spirit Wear Store or from approved vendors listed above. Please remember to follow modest guidelines during Spirit Wear Days.

Students are permitted to wear:

1. Campus wear
2. Blue jeans (no other colors of jeans).
3. Appropriate length blue jean shorts (the "5-inch rule" applies).
4. Modest Providence Academy wear (free of tight or revealing qualities).
5. Presentable clothing (no rips, tears, or holes).
6. Providence Academy-issued T-shirts or the Spirit Wear Store t-shirts.

*Jeggings, leggings, and sweatpants are never permitted.

*Providence Academy wear should not be altered (cut, torn, ripped, etc.).

*On Fridays, Seniors may wear a college jersey of the institution to which they have been accepted.
