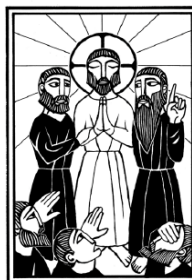

Assisted Suicide

There will be a Second Reading and vote in the
House of Commons for the Terminally Ill Adults
(End of Life Bill) on 11 September.

As Catholics, we oppose this legislation in
principle as it attacks the innate dignity of every
person. It is also very poorly written and gives
no safeguards to healthcare staff, nursing
homes, or hospices all of whom

will be pressured to implement the bill
if the legislation is passed. I encourage

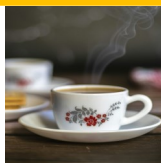

"There is nothing so great as the Eucharist.
If God had something more precious,
He would have given it to us!"

"What is our Lord doing in the tabernacle?
He is awaiting us!"

"Our Lord is hidden there waiting that we
come to visit Him and give Him our
petitions. See how good He is!
He accommodates Himself to our weakness.
If He appeared in glory before us, we would
never have dared approach."

"When we want to obtain something from the

"Are we not happier than Simeon? We can
