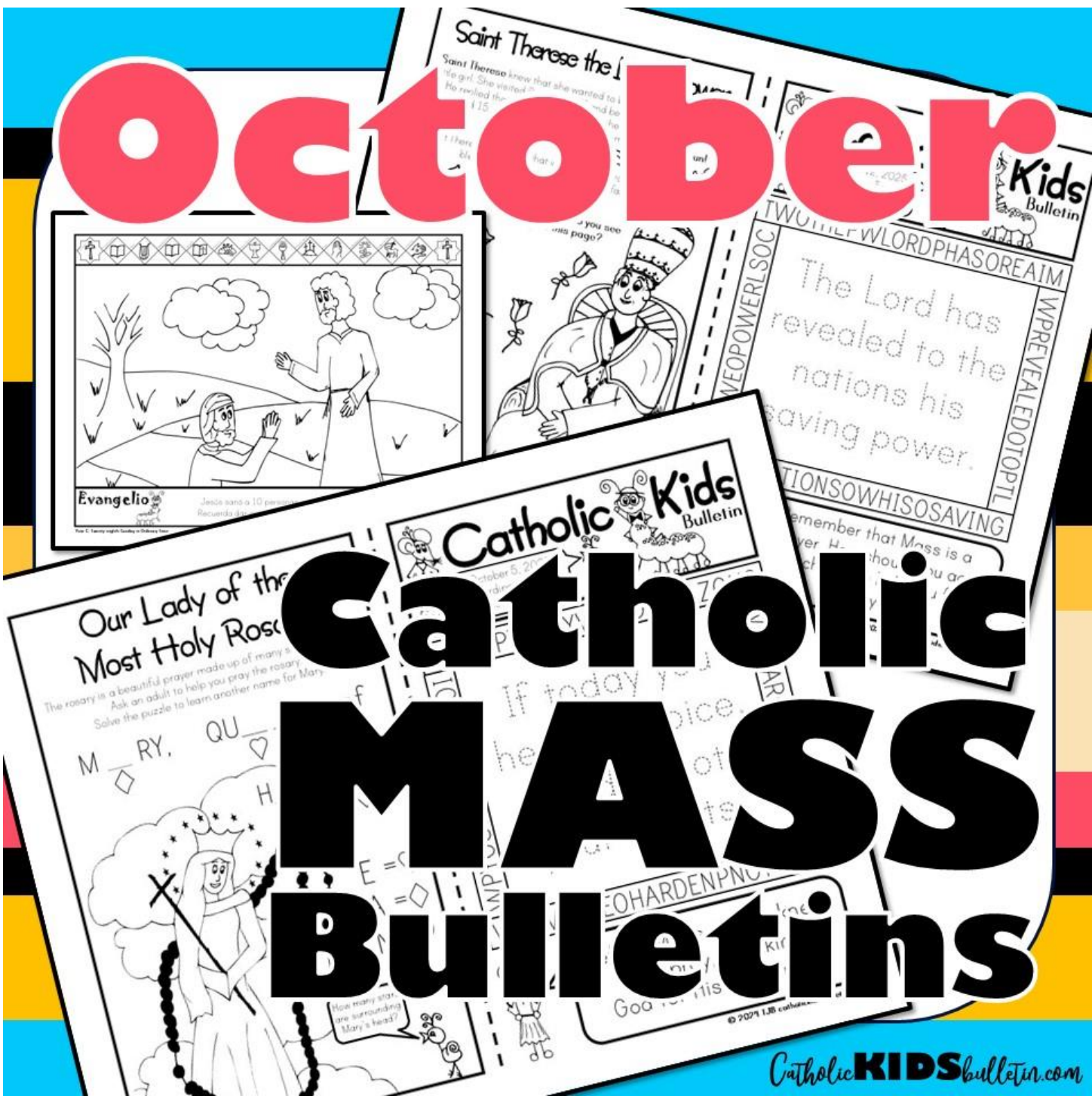

*This download is for use in 1 classroom. If you are using this for a parish or multiple classrooms, please buy multiple licenses based on the number of copies you are printing weekly. This is a rough guide, please adjust as needed based on your financial ability. Ascension is listed without a date because most diocese move that feast to a Sunday; however, there are a few diocese in which it is a day of obligation. I left it without a date so you could use it on the Thursday or Sunday.

Some days, such as Ash Wednesday, Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and Holy Saturday aren't Holy Days of Obligation, but they are included in the download.

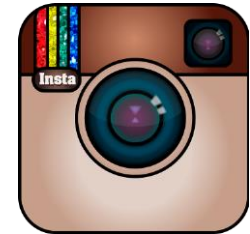

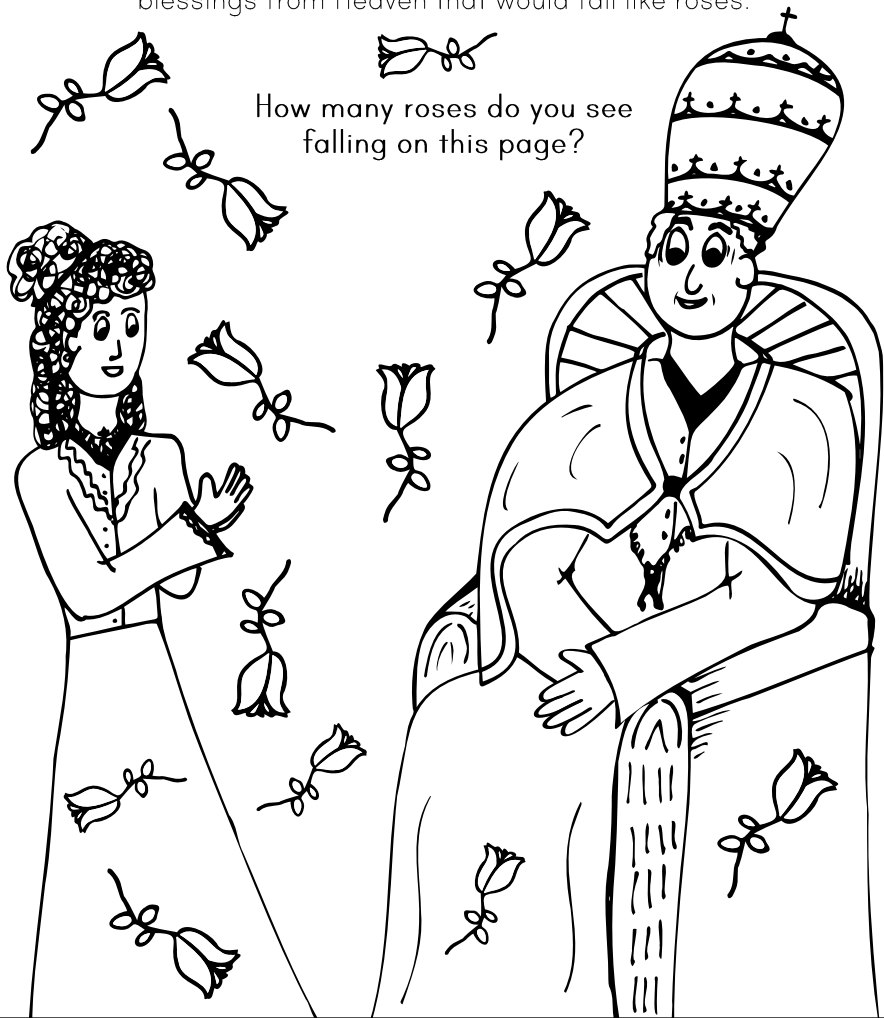


The apostles asked Jesus to help them have more faith, and Jesus told them that even a tiny bit of faith can do amazing things.

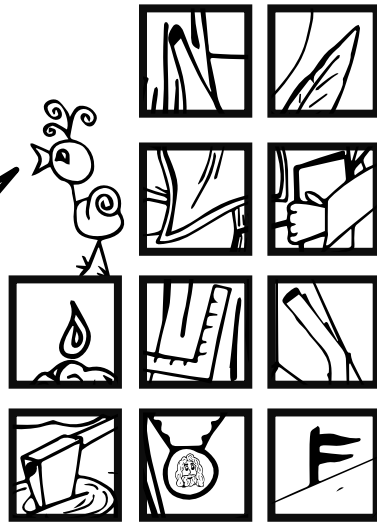


Jesus tells a parable about prayer. He tells you to pray to Him all the time!

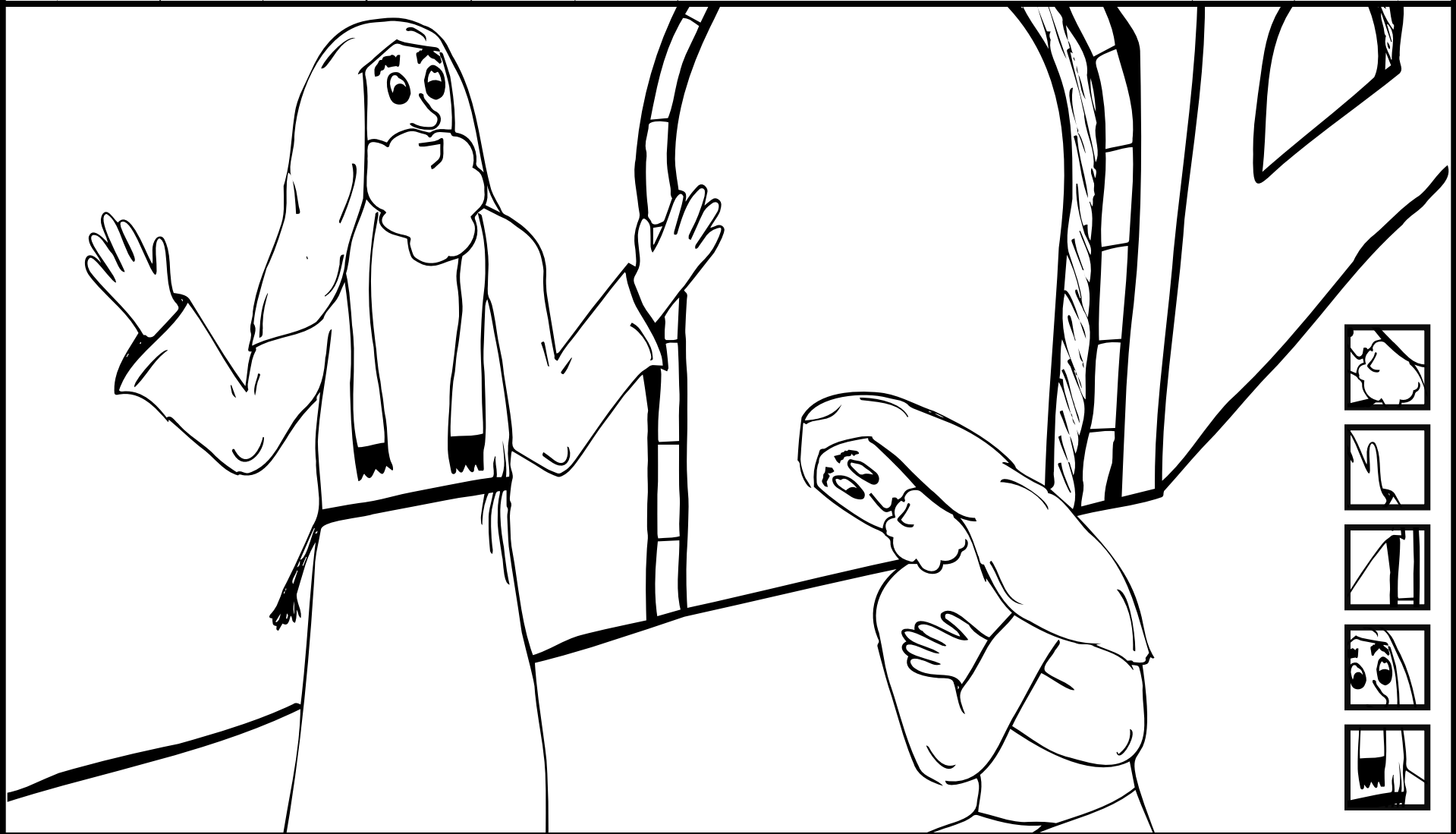
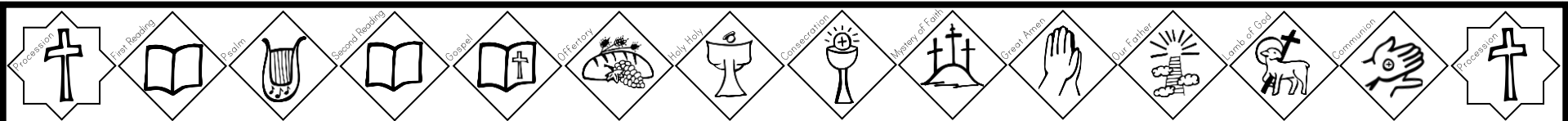
