Virgil P. Morris passed away September 4, having celebrated his 98th birthday on August 23. He was born in Modesto, California and lived much of his life in California, working as a hospital administrator in Los Gatos, South Lake Tahoe, Placerville, Hanford, Port Hueneme, and Hong Kong. Virgil was married to Dee Jacobson Morris for 67 years and to Dolly Kunza Morris for 5 years, both of whom preceded him in death.

Virgil and Dee retired to Angwin, CA, in 1988. Virgil was at different times a member of the PUC, Calistoga, and Yountville Adventist Churches where he served as chorister, deacon, and elder. He was active in the Angwin community during his retirement years as president of the ambulance company, member of the community council, participant in the St. Helena Men's Chorus, and manager of the Good News Broadcasting radio station in Deer Park.

Virgil leaves behind two daughters and their spouses-Marsha and Dwight Crow and Debi and Jeff Blevins; five grandchildren and their spouses, and five great-grandchildren along with a brother, sister-in-law, nephews and nieces.
