37. What opportunities and challenges did the congregation face in 2022?

We have had major building repair needs. There has been no HVAC in the nave since late 2021 and replacement was delayed by pandemic related supply chain issues. New HVAC installation will begin in Spring 2023. We also need and will replace our roof. WE have continued to worship in our parish hall when the weather was too hot or too cold, but this has made in-person attendance difficult for some members and planning new activities difficult. Nonetheless we were able increase our activities of sharing space with music, dance, and yoga classes as well as being the site of a summer day camp teaching bicycling skills and safety.

The congregation is in clergy transition and some members have transferred to other parishes in 2022. Parishioner energy for engagement has been stretched while a committed core group has participated regularly in worship, formation and activities related to parish assessment and interim tasks.

Looking toward the future, what changes do you hope to see in your faith community? What does your community need in order to bring about these changes?

We look forward to completing necessary physical plant repairs so that our church will be a welcoming place and to allow us to try new and creative ways to connect with our neighbors, serve our community and hopefully to attract new members. about participation in a diocesan congregational development program.

We invite you to tell stories of how you have spent the last year naming, addressing, and dismantling the injustices of racism in yourselves, congregations, and your communities.

Our Sunday Eucharist Prayers of the People consistently pray for courage and strength to work for an end to injustice and oppression. A small group conducted a book study of Isabel Wilkerson's 2020 book Caste: The Origins of our Discontents. Our junior warden participated in a diocesan symposium on reparations. We have a small group studying Race and Privilege.
