SAMARITAN MINISTRY NEXT STEP BREAKFAST -- THE ANNUAL NEXT STEP




Breakfast celebrating and supporting Samaritan Ministry of Greater Washington (SMGW) will be at the National Press Club on Saturday, March 14, from 9 am to 10:30 am. This event is FREE, although there is an ask at the end of the breakfast for donations. **All Souls will have a table at this event, as it has in past years.** This is a special Next Step Breakfast celebrating 40 years of SMGW's service to the greater Washington area. **The keynote speaker will be Andy Shallal**, Founder and CEO of the restaurant chain Busboys & Poets, whose life-long commitment to justice, community, and human dignity reflects the values that have guided SMGW for its four decades. **SMGW was founded in 1986 by 11 Episcopal parishes and one Lutheran church, and is supported today by over 40 partner Episcopal parishes, including All Souls.** SMGW provides compassionate, on-going, one-on-one support and mentoring to individuals desiring to "take the next steps" to obtaining housing, employment, high school diplomas, and government IDs and benefits and accomplishing a host of other goals.




IMPORTANT DATES ASH WED / HOLY WEEK
