| Minutes of the May 4, 2025 extra Vestry meeting | A motion was made and seconded to approve the minutes of the May 4, 2025 extra Vestry meeting. | The May 4, 2025 extra Vestry meeting minutes were approved by unanimous vote, and will be sent to the Parish Administrator for posting. |
| Report of the Endowment Grants Committee | John Wiecking provided a report identifying the organizations receiving grants from All Souls for 2025 and the amounts. John also reported that \$1,050 had been raised for the Bishop Walker School from the concert given at All Souls by the Capital Hearings. A motion was made and seconded to approve distributing the \$1,050 to the Bishop Walker School. | The motion to distribute the \$1,050 to the Bishop Walker School was approved by unanimous vote. Mother Sara volunteered to write a thank you letter to the Capital Hearings with the assistance of Cindy Shaughnessy. The Vestry thanked John Wiecking and the Endowment Grants Committee for their work and accepted the report. |
| Update from the Endowment & Investment Board (the Charter of the Board is publicly available on the Parish website) | Jim Solomon presented an update from the Board, describing where the Parish's endowment and investment funds stood at approximately midway through the Board's reporting year, which ends on September 30 th of each calendar year so | The report was accepted with deep appreciation for the work done by the Endowment & Investment Board and by Jim Solomon personally on the Board and in preparing and presenting the update. |

| | that the Vestry can take that information into account in developing and approving a budget effective January 1 of each year. Jim described the five-member make-up of the Board, with staggered five-year terms, so that one member rotates off or stands for reelection per year, with a maximum of two consecutive five year terms allowed. | Mother Sara made a request that the Board provide quarterly reports, rather than semi-annual reports, to the Vestry. |
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| Financial Report | With the authorized draws of \$113,000 from the endowment and \$24,000 from the rectory fund the Parish should have sufficient cash flow for the year based on current projections, even though operating income is projected to be below operating expense. Treasurer Will Stewart noted that income from church use appeared to be running behind, and Jeff Wells was looking into this. Music program expenditures were running a little over, and Will would check into that. Will concluded his presentation by noting with thanks that he is backed up by the excellent work of the Finance Committee, the Endowment & Investment Board, and the Parish's bookkeeper. | The Financial Report was accepted with thanks for Will's work and the work of the Finance Committee, Endowment & Investment Board, and Parish bookkeeper. |
