A Message Regarding the Distribution of All Souls Endowment Grants Thank you for your generosity!

For many years All Souls' has made use of the generosity of former parishioners, as expressed in our endowment, to assist local organizations that do Christ's work in our community, as defined by long-established criteria. This year the Vestry made available \$10,000. A subcommittee of the Endowment Board solicited applications and recently were gratified by Vestry approval of its choices of eight organizations to receive more or less equally sized grants. Parishioners should be aware of the organizations' names and scope of activity, as they are now in a real sense part of our community:

Negotiation Works trains vulnerable people in using negotiation rather than violence to achieve their goals. All Souls sent \$1250.00.

Anne's Place houses and supports people with chronic mental illness or other disabilities. All Souls sent \$1250.00.

Woodley House provides supportive housing and services for DC residents facing mental health disorders. All Souls sent \$1500.00.

Washington School for Girls provides an all-scholarship, academic and faith-based program for elementary and middle-school girls. All Souls sent 1250.00.

Family & Youth Initiative provides services to teens who have aged out of foster care. All Souls sent \$750.00.

The Bishop Walker School provides an all-scholarship, academic and faith-based program for elementary-aged boys. All Souls sent \$1250.00.

The Cleveland/Woodley Park Village creates opportunities for older adults to be actively engaged, supports those who need it with volunteer assistance, and works to create a welcoming community for residents of all ages. All Souls sent \$1300.00.

Christ House provides medical care for homeless men. All Souls sent \$1450.00.
