

and peace, highlighting John the Baptist's call to "make straight the way of the Lord," often symbolized by lighting the Peace Candle (or the second candle) on the Advent wreath, as it's a time to clear obstacles in our hearts and lives for Christ's coming, moving from judgment toward hopeful reconciliation and the "peaceable kingdom" Isaiah foretells.


