

JULY INSTRUCTION TIP



ULTIMATE IRON CONTACT DRILL

SET UP

Place three tees down in the line like the pictures shown below. The outside tees should be just outside the heel and toe of the club.



PERFORMING THE DRILL

Start slowly with small practice swings being able to clip the middle tee and take a divot in front of the ball. Once you have gained an awareness of how to strike the tee and the ground correctly, start making full practice swings. If you are successful, transition to full shots with the ball on the tee each time. Goal: to miss the outside tees and make divot on the target side of the ball.

Saturday & Sunday:


Maximum of three guests in a group. Must be booked after 11:00am.

Dress Code

Please help communicate the following information to your guests as well!

Men shall wear slacks or shorts and a collared shirt. Shirts must be tucked in and shorts must have belt loops.

Females shall wear slacks, appropriate golf shorts, golf skirts or skorts and appropriate golf shirts or blouses.

Golf caps, if worn, must be worn with the bill facing forwards not backwards.

Items specifically not allowed at any time on the golf course or practice facility are: denim, jeans, metal spikes, tee shirts, bathing suits or other swimming attire, cut-off shorts or shirts, tank tops, halter tops, spaghetti strap blouses, cargo pants, cargo shorts, shorts with excessively large pockets, shorts with draw strings, or fitness attire.
