JUNE INSTRUCTION TIP

PUTTING CALIBRATION DRILL

USING STOKE LENGTH TO CONTROL SPEED

Setting Up the Drill

Start with a tee and place your ball down. You will putt from this point each time. Then using the length of a putter, place 3-4 tees down on each side of the ball until it looks like the example of the picture to the right of the page.



Once you have the tees setup, practice hitting putts with the same length backswing and follow through. Use the tees as a reference point. In the example above, this player made a backswing to the #2 tee behind the ball and a follow through to the #2 tee in front of the ball.
