Dear Prayer Partners,

“Being confident of this very thing, that He which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ” (Philippians 1:6). My “good work” was started when He saved me in February 1980 and continued when He started BAFM in 2001 on the streets of Ft Bragg, Parris Island, Hunter Army Airfield, and others. Because of your belief in this mission – giving the Gospel to our military folks – over half a million “little preachers” go where you and I cannot go, telling the story of His love. Thank you for providing the finances to share this Gospel message!

We’ve seen God supply the financial needs for the mission and for my wife Judy and me over the years. God has allowed us to balance all of our needs as well as the mission’s needs thus far, but we’re at a wall right now. We have enough material for the multiple scheduled Memorial Day events in May, but we have enough materials for only half of the packets needed for the 2026 Veterans Day events. We will be short of enough material to col- late the other 10,000 packets needed for that day.

This is the first time in 26 years that we’ve not had materials to fulfill our Veterans Day’s request from churches, so we’ll be shipping out the packets to our BAFM financial supporters on a first-come, first-served basis. We’re trusting God to bring in the finances for 2027’s BAFM’s Veterans’ events that we will be a part of throughout the year.

The materials to fill each packet cost about \$3; with 20 tracts in each packet, this is a very cost-effective method to get out the plan of His great salvation. What can you do to help spread these “little preachers”?
