Dear Pastor and Praying Friends,

January - March 2026

So much has happened in the last few months! I have been challenging our people to develop consistent personal Bible study and learn for themselves what Scripture says. We focused on one chapter per week from Galatians and spent a few minutes each Sunday sharing what we learned. It has been encouraging to watch members take ownership of different aspects of the ministry. For example, one lady volunteered to teach Kids' Church, others now help with instruments during the hymns, and another regularly transports our shut-in ladies to church.

In March, we emphasized missions. I preached on various aspects of missions from the Bible, and we watched a missionary video from around the world each week. The church is beginning to grasp the global need for the Gospel. As a result, several people have started handing out tracts and giving personal invitations.

Please pray for Judy. She attended our services for over a year, trusted Christ under our ministry, and was baptized last September. She had been living at the Care Home with several other residents who attend our church. Without sharing too many details, someone from her past re-entered her life, abducted her, and she is now living with them. Due to legal issues beyond her guardian's control, she cannot return at this time. Please pray for her safety and for her eventual return to the Care Home.

Some of you have asked about my Fire Chaplain ministry. Since January, I have completed all training and now respond to emergency calls as my schedule permits. God is using this ministry to reach people during some of their darkest days.

At the beginning of the year, we faced uncertainty about our meeting place at the community center. After several weeks of testing, God used the situation to teach us greater trust in Him. We are thankful to be still meeting there with no major changes. God has brought other encouraging changes as well. The new family I mentioned in our last letter continues to attend, and our church is once again full of children. We now hold Kids' Church after the main service, and the children are loving the focused lessons. On a sadder note, the Care Home ministry has dwindled to just one resident; the others have moved to facilities much farther away.
