## CHURCH PLANTING MISSIONARIES IN MOZAMBIQUE, AFRICA

It is hard to believe that we have already completed the first month of the new year. We are thankful for all that the Lord allows us to do in Mozambique and pray that we can use this time effectively to reach Mozambicans with the gospel. ### Church in Mahotas

Things at the church are going well. Every week, there are more professions of faith in our outreach ministry. We are thankful for all the Lord is doing with this church and its impact in the community.

Please continue to pray for us and the church in Mahotas. This coming Sunday we will have Friend's Day (February 8<sup>th</sup>). We are praying that we will have many visitors on this day and that many will hear the gospel, possibly for the first time.



### Bible Study in Zimpeto

Things have been going well at the Bible study in Zimpeto, but unfortunately, we have encountered a major roadblock. In January, we had nearly 10 consecutive days of rain, which caused severe flooding in Mozambique. Unfortunately, the house where we have been meeting for the Bible study is still completely flooded with nearly 3 feet of water. We have tried to resolve the problem, but nothing has worked. It seems that it will be at least 2-3 months for the water to dry up. Because of this, we are seeking the Lord's direction. Please pray with us that the Lord would provide another place for our Bible study.



### Bible Study in the market

Each week at the market, more people come for the Bible study. There are normally 10-15 men who come and study the Bible. The Lord is blessing this ministry, and many of these men have already accepted Christ as their Saviour. Please continue to pray for us and this ministry that more people would hear the gospel, be saved, and continue to grow spiritually.

### Furlough this year

In the next few months, we will complete our first 2 years of language and culture training in Mozambique. The Lord has done many great things with us in these last two years. Our faith has been stretched, and we have learned even more about fully relying on God for all things. We are planning a short furlough in June before we return to Mozambique for our first full term of church planting. There are several things that need to be organized for this trip including finding a place to stay near our home church in Tennessee. Please pray with us as we make the necessary arrangements for our short time back in the States.
