CHURCH PLANTING MISSIONARIES IN MOZAMBIQUE, AFRICA

The Church in Mahotas

Things are going well with the ministry in Mahotas. The church is growing, and people are saved every week through this ministry. In January, we began discipleship classes after the Sunday service. This has been fruitful work. Each week, 10-15 people stay after the service to continue to study the Bible. It is exciting to see the spiritual growth of the believers. Next month we will have the 3rd anniversary of the church. Please pray for us as we prepare for this big day. We are planning many things, including baptisms, on this day.



Market Bible Study

Thank you for your faithful prayers for the Bible study in the market. The Lord continues to bless this ministry. Since beginning the Bible study in September 2025, we have seen many professions of faith. Each week, about 12 men come to study the Bible. They are gaining a better understanding of the Scriptures and have begun asking good questions. There is a lot of religion in Mozambique, but not much truth. These men want to know what the Bible says about these religious practices.

One man who joined the Bible study early on is Raimundo. His area of work in the market is far from where we do the Bible study, but he has been faithful to attend. He requested that we start a second Bible study in the market close to his area. After showing his faithfulness, we started working in this area as well. In the first week, 3 men attended. In the second week, 6 men attended. And this past week, 12 people participated in the Bible study. All of them are likely lost. Please pray with me that they will continue in the Bible study, clearly understand the gospel, and be saved.



Visiting Beira

In March, I visited another city in Mozambique, called Beira. This is the second-largest city in the country. A Mozambican pastor invited me to visit. I went along with a young man from our church. We had a very good trip. It was exciting to visit another city in Mozambique and encouraging to spend time with the pastor.

As far as we know, there is no independent Baptist missionary working and serving in Beira. The need for laborers in Mozambique is great. Would you pray for more laborers for Mozambique and for the city of Beira?



Furlough

In June, we will be taking a short furlough. We are nearing the end of our 2-year term of language and culture training. We will go on a short furlough and then return to Mozambique to start our first church. Please pray for us as we prepare for this trip, and that the Lord would continue to work as we return to start our first church.
