**Dear Beloved Pastor and Faithful Brethren in Christ,**

There is no greater confidence in the Lord than knowing that you are praying for us. Thank you very much for your tireless partnership in the Lord. We pray for your spiritual and physical well-being. We also pray that your gracious service toward us, which is a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, will bring you abundant joy. All glory be to God and may we all share in the joy and blessings of serving Him.

**Hope Baptist Church:** We praise God for His saving grace in the lives of Nay Thet Lin and Manasseh, who have followed the Lord in water baptism. Although they attend church from time to time, Manasseh's parents are not yet saved. His father struggles with alcoholism, yet he warmly welcomes us whenever we visit their home and share the gospel. We continue to pray for their salvation. We also thank God for enabling us to hold a special one-day Bible teaching and fellowship for the men in our church. Through this gathering, we were strengthened to become better men in our respective families. By God's grace, we were able to host men's fellowship, and several men from five like-minded churches joined us. I had the opportunity to encourage them with a message on "Leadership God's Way" from the Scriptures. We prayed together and committed ourselves to being servant leaders in our homes, churches, and workplaces for the glory of God.

**Missions Outreach Update:** Our missionaries are faithfully carrying out the work entrusted to them by the Lord. At the Hlegu mission field, Bro. KP Lin conducts regular Bible studies and house-to-house evangelism. I visited and led a one-day Bible teaching session with them. At Chaungsu, Bro. Lian Cin continues to engage in evangelism and tract distribution regularly. The Lord gave me the opportunity to share the gospel one Sunday afternoon. At Waytaya, Bro. Thang Pui likewise conducts Bible studies and house-to-house evangelism. As it is currently summer in Myanmar, four of our Bible college students are assisting by teaching English grammar and speaking to children in Waytaya two days a week. This has proven to be a very effective way to build relationships with the parents for evangelism. There is a great need for permanent locations in both the Chaungsu and Waytaya mission fields. A piece of land measuring 20 by 60 feet costs approximately USD 5,000 in Chaungsu. We humbly ask that you join us in prayer for God's provision.

**Myanmar Update:** I would like to share some updates regarding the current situation in Myanmar. The electricity supply is cut off every 4 hours. City taxis and private vehicles are limited to approximately USD 10 worth of fuel per day. In addition, private vehicles may operate only on designated days (based on odd and even license plate numbers). Government offices have implemented a work-from-home system on certain days each week, and all domestic flights have currently been cancelled. These conditions have led to a noticeable increase in the cost of daily necessities. Though a new government is coming up, it seems nothing will be changed. Despite these challenges, we thank God that we (our fellow workers) can continue the work entrusted to us.

**Family Update:** Our family is doing well by God's grace. My wife, Deborah, is a loving wife and a caring mother. Our children are truly blessed to have her. They are growing up quickly. My son will be entering Grade 12, and my daughter Grade 8, as the school year resumes in June. At the same time, we are concerned about the conscription law, as my son Nathan will turn 17 in June. It would be very helpful if he could leave Myanmar to continue his studies abroad before he turns 18. Otherwise, it may become very difficult for him to leave the country once he reaches that age, according to the current law. We ask for your earnest prayers for God's guidance and provision in this matter.

**Prayer Requests:** (1) for our family's spirituality. We want to represent Christ more than ever. (2) For our church and ministries that God would continue to bless us for His glory. (3) For our country and souls to be saved as we engage in evangelism.
