Dear pastor and friends

As many of you know, we've spent years reaching out to military men and women here and around the world—most in person, many through something as simple (and powerful) as a Bible verse text message. It might seem small, but as one Marine recently reminded us, *God can use even a text at the "wrong" time to reach a heart at the right time*

Here's a short message we received. (shared with permission):

"You may not remember me, and that's ok. Years ago I attended a service while I was in the military and you asked if I'd like to receive Bible verses. I agreed—partly out of kindness and partly to stay barely connected to faith. At one point they got annoying... mostly because they'd show up right when I was drifting and sinning. But somehow, even when I changed numbers, I started getting them again. It felt like God refused to give up on me through your texts. I just started reading the Bible again, and I wanted to thank you for not giving up on me."

When I read that, I had to share it with Ellen and now with you all. You never know what God is doing behind the scenes, or behind the screen.

So often, ministry feels like sending messages into the void—texts that go unread, prayers that seem unanswered, seeds that take their sweet time sprouting. But then someone like this Marine writes, and you remember: God's Word never returns void... even if it's delivered at 2 a.m. by an automated text.

We share this story to say thank you. Thank you for supporting us, praying for us, and believing in this ministry, even when the fruit takes years to show. Every dollar, every prayer, every note of encouragement keeps us going. And every once in a while, we get a message like this that reminds us why we do what we do.
