Dear Pastors and Prayer Partners,

Where did 2025 go? With another year over, I can say again that God is good and God is faithful. Even though almost nothing went as we thought it should, God has greatly blessed us. Sign language classes, interpreting classes, Marie Hopkins' move to the US, monthly trips to Amanda's doctor in Indiana, a new team vehicle, Amanda's strict diet, a late-planned evangelistic trip to Japan and S. Korea, God had His hand on all of this.

As the time for the mission to Japan and S. Korea approached, we prayed for Timothy Pozo's visa renewal to come through, but it did not. After we did all we could, it still did not come. We struggle to understand God's plan in this. Timothy does all our videography to share updates with you, our supporters. He is a bold soul-winner and does much heavy lifting for our team. Amanda responds well to him because he is Peruvian, like her. Not having him in Japan was never on the radar, and leaving him in the US again is not a good option. I ask continued prayer for his visa renewal, especially as we make ministry plans for the new year. God has laid several trips on our hearts to serve foreign nationals and missionaries this year, and we need Timothy to be able to travel outside of the US.



Eighty-one countries were represented at the Deaflympics this year. Our team of eleven gave away nine thousand tracts, spread among several of the Deaflympic venues. We are so thankful for the two people who joined us from Peru, the two from Texas, and the one from Georgia, who built up and encouraged our team and multiplied our reach. In the last few days of the Deaflympics, we found giving tracts to be difficult, because most people already had received one. One man we met shared that he had received five tracts, and being already saved, he gave them to others. After the Deaflympics in Tokyo, we flew to

Sapporo, where missionaries Chris and Kim Walters are eager to reach deaf people of Japan for the Lord. In those five days, we learned so much, and we plan to visit again soon, this time for three months. Lastly, we spent ten days in S. Korea surveying the possibility of starting a deaf ministry there. Throughout the trip, ten people accepted Jesus Christ as their Savior, and we witnessed to countless others. Our spiritual focus for the trip was that God does not require us to create results, but simply tells us to give His message of salvation to people.
