Dear Pastors, Church Families, and Praying Friends,

We began the month in central Illinois for the Open House event of Bible Tracts, Inc. at their headquarters in Odell. Bible Tracts, Inc. (BTI) is a ministry known for providing a wide variety of Gospel tracts, mailed to you at no charge, but they do quite a bit more than that. They also do custom work for a reasonable fee. They'll put your church's logo and information on any of their tracts. Their design team can help you create custom door hangers, special service invitations, or missionary prayer cards which they'll print and ship to you. They've begun producing ministry presentation videos for missionaries, as well as short Gospel films with encouraging testimonies from folks with diverse backgrounds; many of these stories involve someone sharing a tract with them. BTI is an incredibly efficient and effective Gospel distribution mechanism that is able to help your ministry get the Gospel out to the people to whom you minister. We arrived a few days before the event, giving us time to complete a variety of building maintenance tasks before the big day, and to help with setting up. On the Saturday of the event, Angela and I were able to assist with serving food and cleaning up after. We stayed in Dwight through the weekend, worshipping with First Baptist Church of Dwight, IL. Pastor Woodward graciously offered us an unexpected opportunity to briefly share our burden in the evening service. FBC Dwight has been a blessing every time we've visited, and this was no exception!

Midway through the month, GRBC hosted a Ladies' Fellowship at the church. The following weekend, First Baptist Church of Kenmore (OH) hosted their annual Youth Conference.
