Cameron Weage, the Video Production Lead at BTI, was gracious in helping us to compose the messaging in a way that clearly and succinctly explains our burden and calling, as well as putting us at ease in front of the camera. We believe God will use this video to connect us with future ministry partners. We've seen the preliminary video, which is still waiting on a few finishing touches. They've done an amazing job, and we are excited to share it with you soon! We are grateful to Bro. Weage and the team at BTI not only for their help in this area, but for their friendship and partnership in the ministry through the years!

Upon our return from Illinois, we received an envelope from our friends at Memorial Baptist Church in Ocala, FL. Their children's program periodically selects a missionary with whom the church has partnered and spends several weeks learning about them and their field of ministry. Over the course of that time, the class collects offerings to send to that missionary, teaching the children about missions giving. Recently, we were selected for this program! Along with a letter explaining the program, there was a card signed by each of the children, and a check for the funds collected in the offering. We've added that money to our fund for the future purchase of an RV for the ministry (the one we currently use has been graciously loaned to us, but does not belong to us). We are thankful to God for churches like MBC that so actively participate in the ministries of their missions partners, as well as teach the next generation how to participate in their church's missions program! The holidays can also be a challenge because many churches are focused on the evangelistic opportunities brought on by the Christmas season, rendering their schedules quite busy. After spending the holidays away from family last year in Florida working with MBC, it's been a blessing to be home in Ohio this year for Thanksgiving and Christmas (my sister took the photo, so she's not in it)! We pray that you've had a blessed season and year as we all begin to look toward what God has in store for 2026, should He tarry!

With only a couple documents left to turn in for our application, we are excited for the next phase of the application process with World Wide New Testament Baptist Missions to be our missions agency.
