We are privileged to be part of what God is doing here in Malaita. Each day brings new opportunities to share the good news of the Gospel to a needy people. Sundays are going well as we continue to grow a core group of committed Christians. We continue to hold weekly Bible studies with new converts and non-believers that are attending our church.



We rejoice to share that J, a woman that Melodie has been witnessing to and doing weekly Bible studies with, has turned to Christ. She had much confusion due to her cult background. We praise God that she chose to repent and place her faith in Christ alone! Similarly, a young man who recently began attending church has had meaningful discussions with Colton about salvation. After attending evening Bible study, he recognized his need for Christ and called upon God for salvation. He was baptized shortly after. Colton has started an open-air Bible study on Tuesday and Thursday mornings at a market in town. We are grateful to those who donated funds for a

portable sound system, which has greatly improved the ability for people to hear the preaching. There are nearly 200 people that sit down and sell at the bettlenut market, many of whom feel unwelcome due to their lifestyle. I pray God would use His word to pull them close and show them His marvelous Grace that is mighty to save. Pray for us.

As more people come to Christ, we recently held our third baptism service on September 28th. Colton baptized several men, followed by a joyful time of food and fellowship. Auki Baptist is growing and we decided it was needful to charter as a church. On October 12th, we gathered and discussed our personal faith in Christ, baptism and doctrine and founded Auki Baptist Church. We are growing in our knowledge regarding the Bible and seek your prayers for this newly organized church, most of whom are new believer.



We are thrilled to share that we are now official landowners in Malaita, Solomon Islands. Heartfelt thanks to all who contributed to this purchase. Many locals are surprised to hear we are building a home, as it signals our commitment to stay and be part of their lives. Construction is underway. On another joyful note, we are expecting our third child! Melodie is healthy and doing well. She and the boys

will return to the U.S. for a few months for medical checkups and to prepare for the baby's arrival, due February 15th. Colton will join them closer to the due date. Pray for our family as a whole during this time of separation.

Melodie has been blessed with minimal sickness during this pregnancy. This has been good due to an increased number of medical patients. Some require daily care for extensive wounds, while others receive weekly or bi-weekly visits for progress checks and supplies. We are deeply grateful to those who donate to provide these supplies, enabling Melodie to care for those who cannot afford treatment. Please pray that Melodie would be bold and patient to share Christ with these patients. Melodie also extends heartfelt thanks to those who contributed to purchasing a piano for our home. It has simplified her preparation for Sunday worship and enriched our Thursday evening youth singing sessions.
