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Dear Pastor and Friends in the Lord,

"But ye shall receive power after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth"
Acts 1:8. The Lord gave me the opportunity to teach our adult Sunday school class on the topic of mountains in the Bible. They were encouraging lessons, especially Mount Olivet, but I came down with a cold and was not able to teach that lesson. I wanted to encourage others who feel that it is difficult to share the gospel with others. We often forget that God gives us the power to do what He asks of us. According to this verse we have God, the Holy Spirit dwelling within us. He desires to empower us to be witnesses for Him of the salvation He has given to the lost world. Christians often feel we have failed in carrying out this work of sharing the message of salvation. Sometimes we feel we are not knowledgeable enough to share God's Word with others.

I would like to share this true story with you. I talked with a man who had the same concerns that many have when it comes to being a witness for the Lord. He went to a foreign country on a mission trip to do construction work on a school by the church. The country does not allow missionaries but does allow work projects. He thought he could not share his faith, but the people he was working with began to ask him many questions about God. So he started answering their questions, and the people were so pleased to hear more about Jesus Christ and the salvation that the Lord had provided for them. He shared all of his experiences with his church and others. It was a life-changing event for him. Then, he and his wife went again for several months and was able to have Bible studies, prayer meetings and work on a building all while sharing their testimonies and the gospel message. He is back in the USA but misses being in the work and people so he is waiting to be able to return again to do more for the Lord. Even though he stated he has no formal Bible training, he is willing to use what he has learned in his church and personal study to tell others who have never heard. It is marvelous to see how God gives each of us any opportunity to share His Word, not in our own power but in His power. We are privileged to see what God will do and we get to be a part of it all. God is still working in the hearts of men, we just have to be willing to go and tell.

Charlotte and I are busy teaching Adult Sunday School class for 13 weeks, doing breakfast for the bus children, organizing outings for Prime Timers, riding the buses and working in the nursery. We are also enjoying our grandchildren.

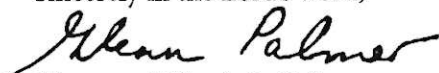
We were blessed to attend our church's marriage retreat with special speaker Pastor Hook from North Carolina. It was a challenging and encouraging Spring Revival at church as well.
