This month we have been preparing curriculum, supply lists, parent handbooks, teacher handbooks, renovating rooms, installing camera systems, and buying all the materials we will need. Teresa has also been preparing the teachers as well, which has been quite the task.

We want to thank all of you who sent funds to help us get this school off the ground. Without your giving we wouldn't have made it this far. We are happy to say that Yeiko and Natzumy books and school materials are fully paid for this year (with promised monthly support). We have been able to pay for their books, supplies, and some new clothes for the school year. We are still looking for help to be able to pay for a tutor for them to reach the level they need to be at for their age. We are also going to provide breakfasts and lunches for the children. If you would like to help with that as well, please let us know. While we still have a way to go, we cannot say thank you enough for the outpouring of support for this school ministry. While the school has taken front stage for this month, our other ministries are still marching forward. The Bible studies continue as well as the meetings in our home on Sundays. Teresa's trauma ministry for ladies continues to grow by leaps and bounds. God has allowed her to not only minister here in Peru, but Central America, the US, and even American Samoa. She has also had contact with others in Canada, Europe, and Africa. Patrick's seminary classes continue to grow as they enter into more topics on how to be a pastor and servant of Christ.

We also have another exciting announcement. We had mentioned before that another missionary left the country but had an NGO still operating here in Lima. We have finally finished the paperwork and it is now in our control! We still have some changes to make, but it is going to make ministering here in Peru so much easier.

On a personal note, Patrick's family was able to visit, which was very nice and refreshing to be around family again. Our children adored the love of their grandparents. Our health has been good and the kids are growing quickly with their language skills. We are still homeschooling them for now, with plans to integrate them slowly back into studying in Spanish as well.
