It’s like many that he has on a regular basis. New pastors and new situations that they have never seen before and are unsure of the path to take. Growing a pastor is growing a church, and there are so many pastors and hopeful pastors that need more training. Training that couldn’t happen without your support!

It has been a whirlwind the last several months. With Teresa’s classes, Patrick’s training, and preparation for furlough, we have been as busy as we can be. As is the norm for us, we rarely store many things in the country over furlough and sell quite a bit. It makes leaving and coming back much easier that way. It is a lot of work in the beginning but pays off in the end.

Teresa has been invited to do a conference at the end of May for trauma healing, so she will be coming back into Peru then to keep her ministry rolling. It is such a large need here and since she can go, teach, and train others to do the same, many areas want to have her in. It is such an opportunity to spread the gospel and strengthen churches through the women’s ministry.

Furlough will be coming up very soon. We wanted to touch on the details briefly. One of the major issues is that Ezra’s sessions are going to be immensely expensive. It also means that housing will be more expensive since we will need to be near the doctor. We hate that these things become the focus, but we will do what is necessary to make Ezra better. To that end, Patrick will be helping a small church while back. They will provide insurance and housing as well as time for us to visit churches. We know this isn’t ideal, but insurance, as you all know, is far too expensive to afford without this assistance.
