Dear Pastor and praying friends,

The last couple of months have been busy with activities at the church and will just keep getting busier over the summer months. Currently there is a group here from the U.S. and will be with us for the upcoming missions conference. It is such a blessing to see a "mission" church become a sending church and to support other missionaries around the world. This is the New Testament pattern. No single country, church, or individual has all the responsibility, but rather, we all have the profound responsibility to be faithful stewards of the gospel message. We will be in the Amazon for a medical connect evangelism trip to Peru and Brazil in June and then conclude the month back here with a week of VBS. There also are a couple of camps planned for the summer.

I have been given the opportunity to preach or teach on Sundays and to help with the mission updates on Wednesday evenings. It has definitely been a great challenge to preach in another language. Please continue to pray for our language development as we desire to have a better ability to communicate with and minister to the people of South America.

Kristia's knee has been improving, but she still has a way to go to get back to "normal." We have ordered her a different type of brace to use during the upcoming trips to the Amazon. Hopefully all the boarding and disembarking will not re-injure or aggravate her injury.

The Visa process is still ongoing with more documentation and a different in-country sponsor being required in order to process the Visa with the Colombian government. We have been working hard to request and obtain all the documents and comply with their requests. The longer they drag out the process, the more we have to redo or update documents that we have already had translated and prepared. It has been a bit frustrating, but we realize that many missionaries go through this all over the world and it is just part of the process. We know God is in control and we are just praying that God gives us favor with the official that reviews our paperwork.

We are also planning to travel to Bolivia and Guyana over the summer months to help with the other Amazon medical evangelism trips. These trips are an amazing opportunity to use medical training to open the door to minister to the spiritual needs of the people.

We appreciate the continued prayers for these requests. The thing of utmost importance for us, within the next few weeks, is obtaining our visas. This step is crucial in allowing us to stay where we are for this time. We have a 90-day window to obtain the needed paperwork. Please continue to pray for my wife's healing and mobility, especially during the trips. Pray for the trips themselves that we see great fruit in these different countries. We will be ministering among several different language groups throughout the Amazon basin. May God give us the ability to communicate the most important message to many who have never heard.

Thank each of you for the consistent prayers and support on our behalf. We are amazed at the friends and co-laborers in ministry that the Lord has provided for us over the past few years that allow us the opportunity to be here in South America.
