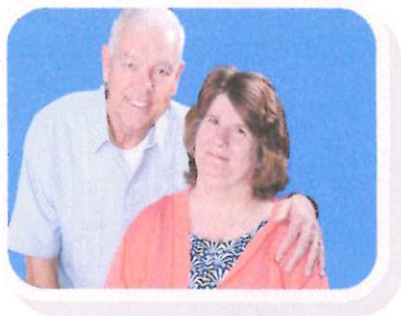

Dear Pastor & Friends:

Greetings and Thank you for praying for your Missionaries. God is so good to us. The last two months has been very busy for us. We traveled over 2700 miles and God's safety and provisions were a blessing to us. We spent some time with Cheryl's sister, Lisa, in Northern Kentucky. We celebrated Roger's birthday on May 11 and our 47th Wedding Anniversary on May 12.

The third week of May we attended the Fellowship Tract League's Camp Meeting for 4 days. It was a great time of preaching and fellowship. We appreciate Pastor Burrows and the church for the wonderful meals and hospitality. Fellowship Tract League is printing 10 million more Tagalog tracts for our ministry by July and we will be shipping them to the Philippines. The Philippines most southern island of Mindanao was shaken by 8.1 earthquake with much damage. This didn't affect our ministry because we are north on the main Island of Luzon.

In May we shipped 45,000 Tagalog/English New Testaments from Bible & Literature Ministry in TN. We thank Pastor Randy Ford and Whitney Baptist Church for giving \$3,000 to help with the shipping. May the Lord richly bless them for their sacrifice. Many souls will be able to receive these Scriptures will be saved and grow in grace.

In June we traveled to Lansing, MI, to be with Parker Memorial Baptist Church, Pastor Jim Green where they printed 300,000 Tagalog Gospels of John/Romans. We scheduled an early loading of a 20 ft. Container but the truck broke down so they sent another driver and truck in the afternoon. After we loaded the container I was able to tell the driver Jose a Mexican man about the Gospel. He was very happy to hear Jesus would forgive him and asked Jesus to save him out by the truck. **This is likely why the 1st truck had complications. I think the Lord had a plan for Jose to be the driver that day so he could hear about Salvation and so he could get saved. Amen! That's just like our Lord and His great love for souls.** We were able to pay for this shipment through the \$3000 that was given by a stranger we met while traveling in Georgia in March through God's divine appointment. Amen.
