Greetings from the Salyer family here in Northern Samar, Philippines.

The month of March officially ended the “rainy season” here, but despite getting drenched on a few occasions, we enjoyed the overcast skies which brought pleasant and moderate temperatures. Also in March, we received reports that all of the 90 large boxes of Bibles sent out, were successfully delivered to 75 different national Pastors and American missionaries in the Philippines. To God be the glory! Thank you for your prayers and financial support that made this Bible distribution project possible. Thousands of whole Bibles, New Testaments, John and Romans, and gospel tracts are being received and sown into the fertile soil of the Philippines. It is our prayer that their eyes will be opened to the Gospel of Jesus Christ and be saved.



In our family ministry, working under Pastor Layne Jones at Lighthouse Baptist Church, it is our desire to be a blessing in any type of service. Heather was able to teach a ladies Sunday School class this period. Jameson was asked to preach twice to the youth and Micah was asked to play the piano on two different occasions. Mike has been able to preach in different conferences. In our effort to witness to our cab drivers, Mike was able to lead one driver to the Lord and give him a Bible. Praise the Lord! The boys and Mike set up a “Free Bible” table on two occasions near busy streets. We were excited to give out whole Bibles and New Testaments to many appreciative recipients. God gave us the privilege to give out Bibles, New Testaments and tracts to a local Criminal Justice College and elementary school. Over 220 graduating students received their own copy of God’s Word.



In April, we took a two-week Survey Trip to the island of Biliran. Our goal was to start the process of prayerfully locating a place to live and minister in the town of Kawayan. On this trip we were able to have a children’s Bible club, visit many sites, and attend five different Baptist churches where Mike was blessed to preach in four of them. We thank the Lord that we were able to deliver many Bibles to these churches and renew and strengthen past friendships.
