Dear Supporters,

We always have a reason to be thankful to God because He is always good to us. He says that anything that comes into our lives is for our good. We only need to think about it, and our hearts will soon be grateful to our great and good God.

<u>The Building Project:</u> This month of September, after the vacation time is over, we will see if we can finance a loan. We need to meet with the bank to see if we can really afford the monthly payment.

The total received up to date by the churches and individuals is \$15,300.00. The amount to pay cash to the owner of the building is \$121,000.00. Besides that, all the document taxes, Notary (notaries are very expensive here in Spain), etc., will be about \$12,000.00. That makes a total purchase amount \$133,000.00. After subtracting the money we have received through your kindness, we have a total \$117,700.00 that we need to borrow from the bank. Lord willing, we will soon find out how much the monthly payments will be.

No matter what happens in the end, we give many thanks to the Lord and to the churches and individuals who have given so generously. Thanks so very, very much for your great help on this matter. Please, pray that we can find the best bank to finance it.

In the Church: The Lord continues to bless us with new brothers and families. Brother Carlos, from Brazil has been attending our services for many consecutive weeks and is very comfortable with the messages and fellowship. His family will arrive, Lord willing, in a few months. Brother Jorge Zaracho, from Paraguay, I think I can say is the one who shows the most interest. He has a great desire to learn, although he knows the Scriptures quite well. He has grown up in a different ecclesiastical context, but he is adapting very well to our teaching and practices, and he understands and accepts them very easily. His family, wife, and three young girls will come, Lord willing, in December. Gilbert and Janeth Parra, a married couple, have been attending for three consecutive Sundays, and they are very participatory. You can tell they genuinely want our fellowship. They have two sons, one of whom is married. They want to come to Spain soon as well. Bro. Mario, from Mozambique is very faithful in his attendance, also. Please, pray for them.

<u>Pray for your missionary:</u> Some two or three months ago, I went to the cardiologist to check my heart. I was feeling some weakness and from time to time a little pain in my chest. This happened especially when walking or exerting myself, but at other times it came when I was just lying on my bed. After several tests, the doctor requested an echocardiogram. Right there, he said: Stop making any efforts.

Finally, they checked my arteries through a CT Scan. The doctor and surgeons decided it was necessary to replace my left aortic valve in the heart. On September 5, they are going to do, as they call it, a TAVI. Please, pray for that.

Gratefulness: We want to again express our gratitude to each one of you for your constant prayers and faithful support, which gives us the possibility to extend the Gospel in Spain. Thank you to all the churches and individuals that have made an extra effort to send their donations for the Building Project. So, we say again, "for the Lord is good!"
