Happy New Year from our family as we continue to serve our Saviour here in the beautiful country of Papua New Guinea. The last few months have been a whirlwind of excitement as 2025 came to a close and we entered into this next year!!

It was also a great blessing to have my parents here for 3 weeks in December. We enjoyed having them here with us during this busy time, but like many such visits, it was over much too soon.

Special Meetings: In December, we were blessed to have a 3- day tent meeting in the neighboring province of Jiwaka. One of our Bible school graduates, Joseph Das, has been laboring in this community of Koindapena since he got saved over 9 years ago. This work was started through the efforts of a retired missionary who previously served in that area. Joseph and his wife were the last converts before the missionary had to leave Papua New Guinea. Because of this, Joseph and his wife never had the opportunity to be baptized. **On the final day of this meeting, I had the great pleasure to baptize them along with 10 other folks who have been saved over the years.** Please pray for Bethel Baptist Church in Koindapena, Jiwaka as they continue to shine forth the light of the gospel of Christ in their community.

Highlands Baptist Bible Institute: On December 18th & 19th, we were blessed to have our first ever graduation ceremony!! **After 3 years of academic and practical study, 24 men and women received a “Diploma of Ministry and Biblical Studies.”** Many of these graduates are pastors and preachers who are already serving in various churches and fellowships all over the highlands. We praise the Lord to see our Bible Institute used to further equip men and women for the ministry!

Kelua Ministry: Please continue to pray for Open Bible Baptist Church in Kelua. In November, we were finally able to start work on our new property. It has been an incredible blessing to see these new Christians dedicate their time and hard work to develop this piece of property for the work of the Lord. There is so much more work to do, including construction of a church building and toilet facilities, but for now we will be meeting under a tent.

On December 14th, we were blessed to host our Mount Hagen Combined service in Kelua. At the beginning of each month, many of our Independent Baptist churches and fellowships in the area have a combined service. It is always a great time of fellowship, singing, preaching, and testimonies. **We took advantage of our combined service in December to hold our first ever church service on our new property.** 3 pastors preached challenging messages both to the lost and saved as we continue forward into this chapter of ministry here in Kelua.

The following week, on December 21st, we held our first baptism service in Kelua! 9 new Christians made the decision to publicly display their new faith in Christ. Many lost family and friends from the community were present to witness this baptism, and some have even come to some services recently. In fact, we have seen quite a few new visitors come to our services recently, and many of them have recognized their need of salvation. A few folks have recently been saved, and many more are clearly under conviction. Please continue to pray for the Lord to work in the hearts and lives of people in Kelua.
