This past Sunday, we were nearly at capacity. Almost every chair in the auditorium was filled, and we had two children's classes on top of that. We still need about \$17,000 to purchase the property. Please pray with us about this. We need the funds by the end of April if at all possible.



In February, we are planning our first baby dedication service at the church, with five children to be dedicated. Please pray for each of these children to come to know Christ as they grow!

Speaking of children, the first person I want to tell you about is **Alesandra**. She was the first real friend Isabella made when we moved here, and her family was one of the first to attend the church. Her older brother and sister were both saved, baptized, and discipled at the church, and this past Sunday, Alesandra was saved! It is wonderful to see someone this young have the chance to know Christ. Isabella was saved in November, another friend at church, Julieta, in December, and now Alesandra. I love that my daughter's friends are coming to know Christ.



Another man I've mentioned several times in prayer letters who is not yet saved is **Daniel**. His wife has been attending our church for almost two years, and he has visited less than ten times. But two weeks ago, he attended the evening service and asked me to start discipleship with him. Since then, we've met every week to study the Bible, and he has not missed a service. There are many frustrations, disappointments, and hardships in ministry, but it is worth it when you see an unsaved person moving toward Christ. He is very open and sincere with questions and is learning. He knows, theoretically, that he is not saved, but the truth has yet to reach his heart. Please pray for him to come to know Christ.

The third person I want to mention is **Alfredo**, a young man at the church preparing for full-time ministry. He recently began preaching five-minute messages on Sunday nights and is improving each time. He was saved at the church on December 1, 2024, and has already been discipling, evangelizing, and preaching since then. Please pray for his continued growth and progress. He recently completed his first year in Bible college and earned enough credits to receive his Certificate of Biblical Studies!



I hope these stories encourage you. Please know that your prayers and support are making a real difference here in Chile. We are so thankful for all of you.
