

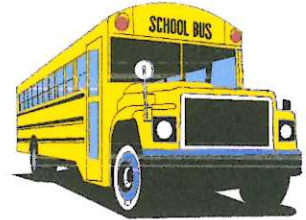


Keep the Buses Rolling

In Billings, Montana, we got to spend time with Darrin II and Lauren and their Bridger and Baby Holland. We are so blessed with five great-grandbabies!

Great News: Dr. Ray Young is heading up a website, busministrynetwork.com, of useful information to help pastors, bus directors, bus captains, bus drivers, bus mechanics, and bus workers with many different resources.
