Recently in Church there were thirteen 2-5 year olds in class, four babies with their parents, and at least two more are on the way later this summer. Equally exciting is the growing support of teachers for these children. May God use us and his Church to reach families in Malta. We hosted our first event for the "5 and under" age group and their

families. Praise God for the 28 that attended and heard the Gospel clearly shared through the Good News of the Gospel. In April, three people were baptized and there is another baptism planned in a few weeks. The Church's Annual Meeting went well and we marveled at God's provision over the last year.
