Dear Gospel Partners,

There's much news to give you from Mexico in this first quarter of 2024. With thankfulness I want to inform you of some pains, amazing blessings, a ministry need, and encouraging news about the construction of the new Hope House facility.

Pains:

During our trip to the United States in the Fall, the man who was co-pastoring with me here began spreading dissension among the congregation that we had started together. He also began to speak in a degrading fashion from the pulpit to the men we have at Hope House and attempted to sabotage the ministry. When we arrived back here in Mexico in December, it was necessary to confront the situation, and separate from him (Rom. 16:17). This has been the most painful and challenging time of ministry I have ever experienced. But from pains come...

With Hope House for Men, and looking toward the opening Hope House for Ladies later this year, we have a pressing need for two new vehicles. Currently, we have a very used public transport van called a "combi", that we recently had to put a thousand dollars into for repairs. Pictured at right, is a 2009 Nissan Urvan, the type of vehicle that we would look to purchase to meet our transportation need. These cost around **\$9,500 USD**. We could use two of these types of vehicles, so we are trying to raise **\$19,000 USD**. These would help us with our need at Hope House, but also to run two routes for the Friday Night Hope Group Meetings, along with Sunday morning routes that we use to bring several people to church.
