Hello and greetings from the small town of Los Ramones, Nuevo León, Mexico. The Lord is good and merciful and we praise His holy name for the opportunity to continue to serve Him on the mission field. Two and a half years ago we started a church here in Los Ramones, and we continue to preach the Gospel and disciple the believers. It has not been easy, nevertheless, we are thankful for the privilege and honor of serving the Lord.

**Rehabilitation Center:** The Lord allowed Bro. Faustino and I to return to the rehabilitation center in Guadalupe with several boxes of Bibles and tracts. On arrival, the director mentioned to us that they had just started a rehabilitation center for women. He continued explaining that he would greatly appreciate it if we could also minister to them. We spent about two hours at the men's rehab and another two at the women's rehab singing, preaching, praying, and answering their questions about the Bible. Five of the ladies made a profession of faith and about twenty of the men did too. To God be the glory.

**Bro. Faustino's Testimony:** It was amazing to see brother Faustino and his wife go back last month to both rehabilitation centers and provide a meal for all of the interns. Faustino told me that they asked him to share a word from the Bible before leaving. It was basically his first time to preach and he did so in front of nearly 60 individuals. He was overly excited to share the news with me. This was a very special moment for him because it was the same rehab where he had spent nearly eight months of his life before getting saved. He had been addicted to drugs and alcohol and was in desperate need of help. After leaving the rehab, he still found himself broken and his family in a mess. He began visiting a psychologist to help him with his problems but only found more hopelessness. After one of his visits with the psychologist, he prayed, "God, if you are real and can hear me, please help me." A couple of minutes later, I walked up to his car at a gas station and gave him a Gospel tract. An hour later, Faustino called me and explained that he and his wife were in the process of getting a divorce and would be signing the papers in two weeks time. He said it seemed impossible for his marriage to be saved. I looked at him and answered, "Mr. Faustino, I don't know you nor your situation, but I do know God, and He can do the impossible." Long story short, Faustino got saved, baptized, and his marriage has been restored by God's grace. Now, he is sharing his testimony with people everywhere he goes including those at the rehabilitation center where he had once found himself addicted and torn by drugs and alcohol.

**Medical Brigade:** A lady at our church, who is a social worker for the government, asked me one day after church if we would be willing to host a medical doctor from the city of Monterrey so that he could attend the sick in our town and give out free medications. This was a blessing because not only were we able to help the sick in our town, but also give them a Gospel tract and a message of hope from the Bible.
