Our lawyer said that we should have had a response already, but with the increase in immigration and the fact that we are in Warsaw, the highest populated city, there is a backlog. Please continue to pray for a quick and positive reply to our visa situation.

Praise the Lord that Pastor Sock, the missionary whose church we attend has made it back safely. We assist in any way we can, from Lisa playing the piano to myself helping to preach and teach. I am still able to teach and preach approximately four times a month. We still go out each week to sow the seed of the Gospel. Pray for God's Word, whether in tract form or presenting of the Gospel, to sink into the heart of the person and convict of sin and salvation. When God gives us the opportunity to converse with one about the Gospel, we always know His Word will not return void. We must be right spiritually so as not to hinder the work of the Holy Spirit.
