

parish community. We said farewell to Fr. Mike O'Keefe, O.Carm. who faithfully served this community for 16 years. Then, I was blest to become pastor in July and am looking forward to many years with the OLMC community. Indeed, what a blessing it has been already. This is an amazing faith community. 
