FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Victorian Government Small Business Immediate Flood Relief Program

A one-off payment of \$5000 for eligible businesses directly impacted by the recent floods in Victoria, to assist with costs such as clean-up, safety inspections, repairs, the hiring of equipment and purchase of stock. To be eligible for a grant, businesses must:

- be located within a <u>local government area</u> deemed eligible for assistance under the <u>Disaster Recovery Funding Arrangement</u>
- hold an active Australian business number (ABN) and have held that ABN on and from 14 October 2022
- be registered for Goods and Services Tax (GST) on and from 14 October 2022
- have incurred significant direct damage from flooding to the place of business, business assets, stock or equipment.

<u>Australian Government Disaster Recovery Payment</u>

A lump sum payment (\$1000 per adult, \$400 per child under 16), for people in eligible local government areas (LGAs) to help with major damage to properties and assets or who have been seriously injured.

Australian Government Disaster Recovery Allowance

Income support payments to employees, primary producers and sole traders who can demonstrate they have experienced a loss of income as a direct result of the floods in

Victoria. If you're eligible, you'll get fortnightly payments for up to 13 weeks up to the applicable rate of <u>JobSeeker Payment</u> or <u>Youth Allowance</u>, depending on the person's circumstances.

Victorian Government Primary Producer Clean-Up Relief Grant

\$10,000 grants to cover the cost of clean-up and get businesses up and running again.

<u>Victorian Government Primary Producer Concessional Loan</u>

Up to \$250,000 to restore or replace damaged equipment and infrastructure, or to cover short-term business expenses.

<u>Victorian Government Primary Producer Transport Subsidies</u>

Up to \$15,000 to support the transport of emergency fodder or stock drinking water, and the movement of livestock.

Victorian Government Community Sport Emergency Flood Assistance

\$5000 one-off grants for eligible sporting clubs to assist with the replacement of lost, damaged or destroyed items.

Rural Financial Counselling Service

Free financial counselling to farmers and small businesses who are in or at risk of financial hardship. Call 1300 771 741.

<u>Victorian Government Business Relief Service (13 22 15)</u>

As part of the Small Business Immediate Flood Relief Program, one-on-one support is available from a local business relief adviser to guide business owners through the available Commonwealth, state and local supports. They can also help you manage insurance and landlord issues, assess impacts and form strategies for recovery. Business relief advisers will be available via telephone and on the ground. To access the Business Relief Service, call the Business Victoria hotline on 13 22 15 and they will connect you with dedicated relief advice and support. The hotline operates seven days a week. If you require a translator, please let the operator know and they will call the Translating and Interpreting Service.
