Farm Ubuntu is the flagship agricultural development program of Towards a Better World Charities (TABWC) in Namibia.

Located on a 17-hectare property 25 km west of Swakopmund, the farm operates as both a productive agricultural enterprise and a practical training environment.

The program demonstrates how vegetables can be grown sustainably and commercially in an arid environment while creating opportunities for employment, skills development, and community participation.

WHAT WE DO

Farm Ubuntu combines production, training, and enterprise development to strengthen local food systems and support long-term economic resilience.



Vegetable Production

Commercial-scale vegetable production supplying fresh produce to the local market while demonstrating practical, climate-appropriate farming techniques.



Agricultural Training

Hands-on training programs that build the technical and business skills needed for sustainable vegetable production and viable small-scale farming.



AgriHub

Supporting emerging farmers through access to land, mentorship, and shared resources, helping them develop their own agricultural enterprises.
