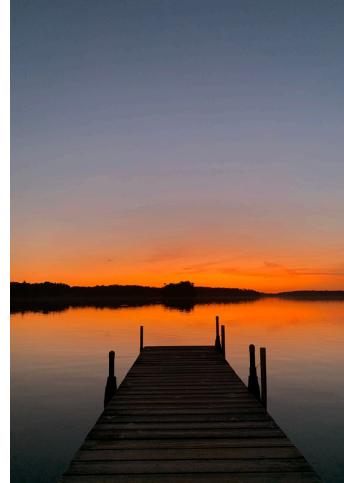

Two Successful Boater Safety Events!

The Lake Madison Development Association (LMDA) held two boater safety events since our last Anchor News edition. The first was our 3rd Annual Boater Safety Golf Tournament held Saturday, May 30th at the Lakes Golf Course. Despite the challenging weather forecast, we had a great turnout and the weather held out for us to get the tournament played, so we were grateful for that. We had twelve teams of four show up and a couple of teams chose not to fight the weather, so all in all a good turnout for a total of 48 participants. As always, our community businesses stepped up and donated numerous prizes, so we awarded six PIN prizes as well as paid out money and prizes to our top four teams! This is our largest fundraiser for boater safety and once again the event did not disappoint! A great big THANK YOU to all of the participants and to the Lakes Golf Course and staff for hosting this event for us, it is so greatly appreciated!!

Our second event, our 3rd Annual Boater Safety Training was held Saturday, June 13th at the Hillside. This too was a very successful event as we had twenty participants in this training! The Game, Fish & Parks department was a key player in putting on this training for us, and as always, did a super job. The structure of this training is a series of videos covering all aspects of operating watercraft (boats and jet skis) and the rules of the water ways. The laws were also covered and discussed. This is a very interactive training, and with the participants this year that interaction was fantastic! It's exciting to see parents bringing their kids to this training and the kids interacting as they were. GF&P encouraged everyone to share what they learned with their friends, family, and neighbors and encourage others to come to this training next year as well. Each participant received a bag of goodies and a Certificate of Completion that they can proudly display. We also gave away several door prizes. A great big THANK YOU to all of the participants that came out, the Hillside and their staff for hosting this event for us, and to the GF&P, we couldn't have done this without all of you!!

Both of these events are held in memory of Emmy Gorman, 'Remembering Emmy.' We realize there are many others that have lost their lives on Lake Madison and surrounding areas. However, the impact and circumstances around Emmy's death is what has precipitated the movement and changes in SD laws with aligning penalties between the waterways and the roadways. For that, we are grateful!

Clean. Drain. Dry. Everytime.

Clean. Drain. Dry. Everytime - A simple but powerful message when talking about slowing the spread of aquatic invasive species (AIS). Whether its aquatic plants, mud, water, or mussels, AIS love to hitch rides on watercraft and is the strongest vector for spread. Before and after launching your watercraft make sure to clean your exterior haul or your watercraft and trailer. Drain all water and pull all watercraft plugs (livewell, main or bilge, and ballast tanks). Some recreationalists may not know this but there are two plugs on the back of jet skis they need to pulled. All plugs should be removed before exiting the boat ramp parking lot adjacent to your access. Lastly, dry your watercraft before each use when possible. Wakeboard boats can have several ballast tanks and many are removable. If possible, remove these ballast tanks and drain all water as many gallons of residual water cannot be removed when you hit the drain function on your watercraft. Every boater with an inboard/outboard or outboard motor should also lower their lower unit and remove any residual water the lower unit may be holding. Zebra mussel veligers are microscopic and can be transported in water unseen to the naked eye. They also can survive out of water for up to 30 days when conditions are right. Aquatic invasive plants can spread by fragmentation, so even when your prop chops up vegetation, doesn't mean you can't spread that nuisance plant to a new water. AIS can also be present in mud so make sure to clean off your anchor before leaving the water. Again, Clean. Drain. Dry. Everytime and with everyone's help we can protect Lake Madison from AIS invading this beloved lake!

Is Your Boat Ready for Summer?

Summer is here, and a quick maintenance check now can help ensure a safe, trouble-free season on the water. Regular maintenance helps prevent breakdowns, improves performance, protects your investment, and keeps your family safe while enjoying the lake.

Top Priorities

- **Engine & Fuel:** Change oil and filters if needed, inspect hoses and belts, check fuel lines, and look for leaks. If fuel has been sitting all winter, consider adding a fuel stabilizer.
- **Battery & Electrical:** Test batteries, clean terminals, inspect wiring, and make sure navigation lights and electronics are working properly.
- **Hull & Running Gear:** Check the hull for cracks or damage and inspect the propeller for dents, bends, or fishing line.
- **Safety Equipment:** Confirm life jackets are available and in good condition. Check your fire extinguisher, horn, throwable flotation device, first-aid kit, and any required emergency equipment.
- **Bilge & Pumps:** Test bilge pumps and clean out any debris to ensure everything operates properly.
- **Trailer:** Inspect tires, bearings, lights, winch, safety chains, and tie-down straps before heading to the lake.

When to Act

Complete a final inspection before your first launch of the season. If you discover fuel contamination, structural damage, major engine issues, or anything you're unsure about, contact a qualified marine mechanic or marina for assistance.

A little preparation now can prevent a lot of headaches later. Schedule your pre-season inspection today and enjoy a safe summer on Lake Madison.

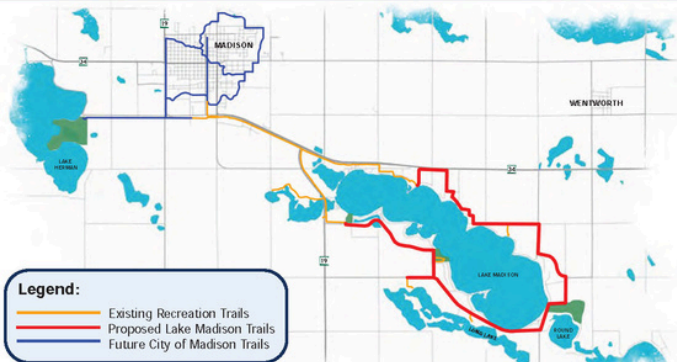
