Safeguarding Children Declaration - Youth Football

As A Club Providing Youth Football We Will:

Name a Club Welfare Officer and proactively share and promote their details will all Parents/Carers, Club Officials and Coaching Teams.

Adhere to the FA's Safeguarding Children Policy and Procedures and proactively share our Club Safeguarding Policies with our members (Players, Club Officials, Coaching Teams and Parents/Carers).

Ensure all Coaches and Assistant Coaches are named on the FA systems for every team and their details are accurate and up to date.

Maintain in date accepted FA DBS checks and required Safeguarding Courses for all those working directly with Under 18's

Refer Safeguarding concerns in line with the FA's Safeguarding Policy and Procedures.

Ensure there are a minimum of two DA DBS checked and Safeguarding trained Adults in place for all Club organised activities.

Commit to creating a child centred culture.

If we run activity for 4 and 5 year olds (Play Phase) we will also:

Ensure a specific Safeguarding Risk Assessment is completed for our 'Play Phase' activity.

Have a formal registration process for each session.

Proactively communicate the availability of toilets and hand basins.

Require Parents/Carers to supervise their child(ren), including intimate care needs.

Have a 'Missing Child Protocol'.
