

7 August 2026 - Day of Prayer & Fasting:

Theme: Seeking Holy Spirit revelation, discernment, wisdom and understanding

We are meditating on the theme of '*seeking Holy Spirit revelation, discernment, wisdom and understanding.*' The Holy Spirit, as the third person of the Trinity, plays a crucial role in imparting revelation, wisdom, understanding, and guidance to those who earnestly seek God. For Christians, seeking revelation through the Holy Spirit involves a dynamic relationship with God, characterized by prayer, meditation on Scripture, and openness to the Spirit's leading. The Holy Spirit is described as a counselor, teacher and helper in John 14:26.

Our lives can be transformed through the presence of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit acts as our helper and guide, reminding us of God's promises and inspiring us to live in accordance with His will. We often seek clarity in our lives, and the Holy Spirit serves to enlighten our minds and deepen our understanding. By recognizing the active role of the Holy Spirit and listening to Him, we can better submit to His guidance and direction.

The below verses reflect this '***Seeking Holy Spirit revelation, discernment, wisdom and understanding***' theme and so please read and meditate on each passage to see what God may reveal. Try reading each aloud and putting the verse into a prayer, applying it as appropriate to your situation, your family, our church family and its ministries.

- Pray that we would be open to the Holy Spirit teaching us more about living in step with Him. (Gal 5:25)
