Through bible verses about walking with God, we are reminded that God desires to walk closely with His people - guiding, strengthening, correcting, and comforting them. When we choose to walk with Him, we align ourselves with His purposes and experience the fullness of His presence in our lives.

The below verses reflect this '**Walking with God**' theme and so please read and meditate on each passage to see what God may reveal. Try reading each aloud and putting the verse into a prayer, applying it as appropriate to your situation, your family, our church family and its ministries.

- Pray that we would know the fullness of the 'blessings of fearing the Lord and walking in His ways' (Ps128:1)
