SUN PROTECTION PROCEDURE

Outcome

To promote sun protection practices to reduce tamariki's exposure to UV radiation and their risk of skin cancer.

Procedures

- During Terms 1 & 4 all staff and tamariki will be required to wear a **school** sun hat when outside.
- The playground areas will be maintained with shade trees so tamariki can play in the shade.
- When playing sports or engaging in outside activities after 10am staff will ensure tamariki are wearing sunhats.
- Sunscreen will be available in the office for school events outside that are longer than 20 minutes.
- The Sun Protection Procedure will, where possible, be reinforced in a positive way through ākonga and kaiako activities.
- All children are expected to wear sun hats and sunscreen for activities such as sports days and outdoor activities that necessitate extended periods outside.
- All staff are required to wear a sun hat (no caps) when on duty and when outside for teaching and learning.
