

It relies on direct donations (online or by check with Cecilia McKay in Memo). We all know how electric bills have gone up...but what if you were living on the edge financially. In April, May and June we have helped 45 families overcome financial issues (37 for BGE); 125 requested assistance; we cannot help everyone (ask Dick Moore for the criteria). In those three months Cecilia McKay has disbursed over \$9,000 total! Without your help we will have to say no to even more folks in need. Please consider earmarking \$50 or \$100 to Cecilia McKay Fund for families in need. Thank you
