

In April, May and June we have helped 45 families overcome financial issues (37 for BGE); 125 requested assistance; we cannot help everyone (ask Dick Moore for the criteria). In those three months Cecilia McKay has disbursed over \$9,000 total! Without your help we will have to say no to even more folks in need.
